

Sundström Cider is one of the country's most forward-thinking cideries, focused on varietal typicity, terroir, promotion of improved variety selection in the orchard, progressive orchard practices, and minimalist cellar work. Working with sustainably grown, heirloom apple varieties from historical cider-producing regions around New York State, Sundström Cider makes small quantities of dry, vinous ciders. They are complex, textural, acid-driven and meant to age and evolve in bottle.

Traditionally crafted hard cider, made only with apples grown on this over 100-year-old family farm founded by Henry Morgenthau Jr., Secretary of the Treasury under Franklin D. Roosevelt. They grow 80 varieties, which are picked as late as possible, allowing more flavor to develop, then pressed in small batches on a traditional rack and cloth press.



Denning's Point Distillery

Fine artisanal spirits are distilled from locally sourced grains milled onsite and fermented in a 250-gallon custom hybrid still, handcrafted by Vendome Copper and Brassworks of Kentucky. Stop by for tastings, cocktails and live music on weekends in this downtown 19th century building.

Dutch's Spirits at Harvest Homestead Farm

Raided by Prohibition agents in 1932, 400-acre Dutch's Spirits was once home to the bootlegger Dutch Schultz's underground moonshine making operation. It was the most elaborate and illicit liquor-producing operation ever found in Dutchess County. In 2020, 88 years to the day, the first batch of Sugar Wash Moonshine blended in Pine Plains since prohibition was bottled at the distillery, just steps from the original bunkhouse.

The spirits are double-distilled in a traditional French alembic pot and all processing, fermenting, distilling, barrel-aging and bottling are done on-site. Even the rye and over 120 varieties of apples are grown on the farm. Open year-round for tours and tastings by appointment.


